Project Police Corruption Part 2



Corruption amongst law enforcement agencies in South Africa has grown.

This applies to Police Officials, Metro Police and Specialised Law Enforcement Agencies.

- **Definition:**

- **According to The Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act No.12 of 2004 corruption is defined as:**
 - ✓ Any person who directly or indirectly accepts or offers any gratification from any other person, whether for the benefit of himself or herself or for the benefit of another person: or gives or agrees or offers to give to another person any gratification for the benefit of another person in order to act personally or by influencing another person so as to act in a way that amounts to illegal , dishonest , unauthorised , incomplete or biased misuse or selling of information or material acquired in the course or exercise , carrying out or performance of any powers , duties or functions arising out of a constitutional , statute or contractual or other legal obligation that amounts to the abuse of a position of authority, a breach of trust , or the violation of a legal duty or set of rules designed to achieve an unjustified result, or that amounts to any other unauthorised or improper inducement to do or not to do anything, is guilty of the offence of corruption.

Types of Police Corruption in South Africa

1. Sextortion and Police Violence Against Women:
 - Male police officers doing a strip search on female victims.
 - Police officers will stop females walking in the street, accuse them of prostitution, and then sexually assault them.
 - Female sex workers performing sexual favours for police officers, to avoid arrest.
2. Corruption of authority:
 - When police officers receive and willingly accept free drinks, meals, and other gratuities, whether intentionally or unintentionally, is classified as corruption.
3. Bribery & Extortion:
 - Receiving or demanding a form of payment in order to overlook a crime or a possible future crime.
 - **Bribery will take place in the following scenarios:**
 - ✓ Protect or overlook illegal activities.
 - ✓ To not arrest a violator.
 - ✓ Altering testimony.
 - ✓ Withholding evidence or failing to appear at judicial hearings.
 - ✓ Destroying evidence.
 - ✓ Selling private and confidential criminal information.
4. Theft and burglary:
 - Stealing from an arrest, crime victims or corpses.
 - ✓ Taking drugs for personal use.
 - ✓ Taking personal objects from a corpse at the scene of a crime.

-
- ✓ A theft can also occur within a department. An officer can steal property from the department's evidence room or property room for personal use.

5. Perjury:

- Lying to protect other officers or oneself in a court of law or an internal departmental investigation.

6. The planting or adding to evidence during a criminal investigation.

7. Ticket fixing:

- Police officers reducing or cancelling traffic tickets as a favour to the friends and family of other police officers.



Latest reported incident

On the evening of 26 February 2020 at about 21:00, a Senior Director in the Motor Industry, was on his way home from a dinner meeting at Carafa Restaurant in Menlyn, Pretoria area. On the corner of Lynnwood Road and Rodericks Rd, Lynnwood, he was flagged down by a Police Officer in what appeared to be a Police Roadblock. There were several Police Officers present, dressed in Police Uniform. The Director was then asked whether he had anything to drink in the form of alcohol. The vehicle he was driving was a Porche 911. He told the officer that he was on his way home from a dinner meeting, but that he had consumed no alcohol. The officer then asked him to blow into a device that was portrayed as a breathalyser. The Director noticed that the device didn't look like any device used for this purpose he had ever seen but complied. The reading on the device came out to be 0,35. The Officer then threatened the Director with arrest. The Director was very surprised and asked the Officer if he could repeat the test. He subsequently did and the reading/result was the same. Realising that something was out of the ordinary, the Director then suggested a blood test. He was told to rather continue with his journey and left.

Conclusion

Any Police Blockade during which any breathalyser tests are conducted, must be able to present a certificate of compliance of the device used in testing and a certificate showing that training on the specific device was completed by the Official executing the test. In this case, the following facts are questionable:

- The device used
- Compliance to certification and training on the device
- The reading seemed to be unreliable
- When a blood test was suggested by the Official, he was released

- The authenticity of the Police Blockade
 - The authenticity of the Police Officers

It is very clear that the motive for the "test" was in all probability a way to extort a bribe from the driver.
